The Australian National Imams Council

The Australian National Imams Council (ACN 122 669 318) is registered as a public company limited by guarantee.

The Council as an official entity is recognized by the Australian securities and Investment commission and is dictated by its constitution.

The Council is the 'umbrella' of the following councils:

1. Council of Imams & Dua'ats NSW
2. Imams Board of Victoria
3. Imams Board of Western Australia
4. Council of Muslim Scholars and Imams QLD
5. Imams of South Australia
6. Imams of Tasmania
7. Imams of ACT

The respective councils must nominate three Imams from their respective states as delegates to the conference or one delegate in the case of Tasmania and South Australia, which then forms The Australian National Imams Council.

The Australian National Imams Council is the only official body that has the right and the authority to nominate and elect the position of "Grand Mufti of Australia" in a free and fair election without any internal or external interventions.

The council will in early 2007 hold a general conference of Imams in Australia, in order to discuss and approve (amongst other things):

1. The strategic plan for the future of all Muslims in Australia
2. Regulatory affairs for the Imams in all Australian States, and
3. The Mufti of Australia

The Council further announces that it is ready, willing and able (with complete sincerity) to cooperate with all and any official bodies (Government and non-Government) and whether they maybe Islamic and non- Islamic organizations for benefit of both the Australian Muslims and the wider Australian community.
